Wal-Mart Proposes New Store In East Patchogue

East Patchogue, NY, (September 16th, 2008) -- Wal-Mart announced it has filed plans to build a new 120,000 square foot store in East Patchogue, New York, at the northeast corner of Hospital Road and Sunrise Highway. Plans were filed with the Town of Brookhaven and are in the early stages of consideration.

The new store will provide approximately 200-250 new jobs. The average hourly wage for regular full-time associates in New York is \$11.53/hour. Both full-time and part-time associates are eligible for benefits including medical, 401 (k), profit sharing, stock purchases and bonus incentives. The proposed store also is expected to pay tens of thousands of dollars in local property taxes annually.
